She received her bachelor's degree in politics from Wake Forest University in 1972 where she graduated Magna Cum Laude and was inducted into Phi Beta Kappa. She was also a member of the Fideles Society. She received her Juris Doctorate from Wake Forest School of Law in 1975, where she was a member of the Phi Delta Phi legal fraternity.

After law school, she served as Assistant District Attorney in New Hanover and Pender counties for ten years where she prosecuted hundreds of cases before North Carolina juries. From 1984 to 1992, she maintained her own practice in the areas of civil and criminal law in Southport.

Mary and Mike Easley have been married for 26 years and have one child, Michael Jr., age 22.
